Players may only participate in one of the three League competitions so once a player has played for one of their club's teams, they cannot play for any other team even if their original team gets knocked out although a dispensation can be requested from the Fixtures Secretary. For the semi-final and the final, all players must have been registered by the club for 28 days and where a club has two or more teams, a player is not eligible to play unless that player has played in at least two League matches for the cup team although a dispensation can be requested from the Fixtures Secretary. No player can play in the semi-final or final unless they have been registered with the League for a minimum of 28 days.

The team which has the highest aggregate score will be awarded the match. Should the aggregate scores be equal then the team having the most individual winners. If still equal then the team with the player(s) having the highest differential score. If there is still no clear winner then there will be a one end play off between two players nominated by each team captain and the lead will be tossed for.
